A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SHASTA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT PROVIDING WORKERS' COMPENSATION COVERAGE

WHEREAS, the Shasta Fire Protection District's Board of Directors desires to provide workers' compensation coverage for paid and volunteers pursuant to the provisions of Section 3363.5 of the Labor Code; and

WHEREAS, the District's Board of Directors finds its best interests will be served by utilizing firefighters in the provision of certain District services; and

WHEREAS, said firefighters should be eligible for workers' compensation coverage while on duty;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Shasta Fire Protection District hereby finds and determines: That the public interest is best served by providing workers' compensation coverage to:

- 1. Fulltime Paid Firefighters
- 2. Paid on Call also known as Volunteer Firefighters
- 3. Paid Seasonal Firefighters
- 4. The Firefighters described above shall be deemed to be employees for the purposes of Division 4 of the California Labor Code while the person actually performs paid or volunteers services, provided that the rights of volunteers shall be limited to those benefits set forth in the Labor Code.
