To Old Shasta Community Members.

Once again, we are sending out the Work Sheet for our FireWise program. Hopefully, you remember receiving lasts years. One of the requirements to remain in good standing with the Shasta County Fire Safe Council is to show proof that our community is continuing to remove debris/trees/dead leaves etc. so that our property will be more fire safe. That is what this form is for. We will be reporting an estimated amount of what we have removed (burned).

So, let's say you raked up dead leaves. Most of us either burn or compost those. If you were looking at your pile, and were estimating how many leaf and lawn bags you would have to use to haul them off then that is the number you would put into the box for estimated debris removed. Same thing for a burn pile of branches or brush, you would estimate if it would be a truck load or more. Then put that number into the corresponding box. If you have spent time weed eating or spraying to keep the brush from coming back, then estimate how much you would have had to pay someone to come in and do the work and report that amount in Money Spent. Do not spend any time trying to figure out cubic yards.

VEGETATION REMOVAL FORM

A major component of wildfire risk reduction is the removal of vegetation from individual properties and common area property. Tracking vegetation removal provides fire agencies with information on the quantity of potential wildfire fuel that has been eliminated from the community.

- Use the following options to estimate the amount of vegetation removed:
